About Dr. Kevin Armstrong

Dr. Armstrong was passionate about sports and the positive impact that they could have on children and adolescents. As a respected orthopedic surgeon, he found a fitting career that embodied his love of sports and dedication to community service. Fittingly, the Kevin Armstrong, M.D. Memorial Sports Foundation was established in celebration of Dr. Kevin Armstrong's life and his belief that students of modest economic means could achieve higher goals if they received the proper support, inspiration and opportunities.

Dr. Armstrong's enduring connection to Santa Ana began as a child. He attended Diamond Elementary School and was Associated Student Body (ASB) President and Valedictorian for the class of 1979 at Carr Intermediate School. Having lost his father at a young age, he experienced firsthand the value of sports programs.

Although his family later moved to Irvine, the lessons of hard work and discipline were ingrained. He was among the first graduating class of Woodbridge High School in 1983, where in addition to serving as ASB President, he participated in football, basketball and track & field. Dr. Armstrong received numerous scholastic and athletic awards while in high school including the Irvine Company's Leadership Award.

In 1987 Dr. Armstrong graduated from Princeton University where he received an undergraduate degree in Molecular Biology and also served as co-captain of the football team. After earning his medical degree he became a volunteer physician at SAUSD high school football games.

Still in the early stages of his medical career, Dr. Kevin Armstrong died suddenly in May 2005 of a rare heart condition at the age of 39. A scholar, mentor, respected physician and pillar of the community, Dr. Armstrong's legacy lives on in the many lives he affects through the Kevin Armstrong, M.D. Memorial Sports Foundation.
