13,000 intermediate school students served by KAMSF since 2005

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RunStrong students are excelling athletically and academically!



RunStrong provides Santa Ana students athletic opportunities that they would not normally have by sponsoring their participation in 5k/10k races in Orange County. **RunStrong** began in 2010 with 50 students from three Santa Ana Intermediate schools. Since then, participation has grown to over 150 students from seven Santa Ana Intermediate and K-8 Schools competing in four races per school year. Dedicated coaches commit hundreds of volunteer hours training and preparing students before and after school for race day. Coaches are sharing their passion for running and serving as mentors



and counselors. On race day, the energy level is high and the excitement is palpable even though many Santa Ana students are competing for the first time. As they position themselves at the start line with seasoned runners from all over Southern California, **RunStrong**

students are prepared and anxious to begin. Their hard work and commitment pays off. Year after year **RunStrong** students medal in their respective age groups with many students achieving their personal best during the school year only to better their times the

following school year. Santa Ana students now have a prominent place in the Orange County running community. **RunStrong** provides fun, safe, and healthy opportunities for students and they are proud of their accomplishments, staying in school and excelling academically and athletically.
